


INDEPENDENCE DAY- 15 AUGUST 2020


FIT INDIA RUN-24 AUGUST 2020


THE NCC DAY-21 NOVEMBER 2020

18. PULWAMA DAY-14 FEBRUARY 2021






WORLD DAY OF SOCIAL JUSTICE-20 FEBRUARY, 2021



On September 16th, an Intercollegiate Poster competition was organized based on the focal theme 'Ozone for Life'. 7 Colleges participated.








WORLD WATER DAY 2021






