A pilot project to check the quality of water in wells got under way at Paravoor municipal area and Kalady panchayat on Saturday. The quality check on water is being carried out jointly by the Department of Local Self-Government, Hairtha Mission and the Kerala State Pollution Control Board, says a press release here on Saturday.

The project target is to complete tests on water in 3,000 wells within over Saturday and Sunday. Two mobile laboratories each have been made available in the municipality and the grama panchayat. Volunteers from SNM College, Mallyankara, and Sree Sankara College, Kalady, will collect water samples and take them to mobile laboratories where they will be tested for quality, adds the release.

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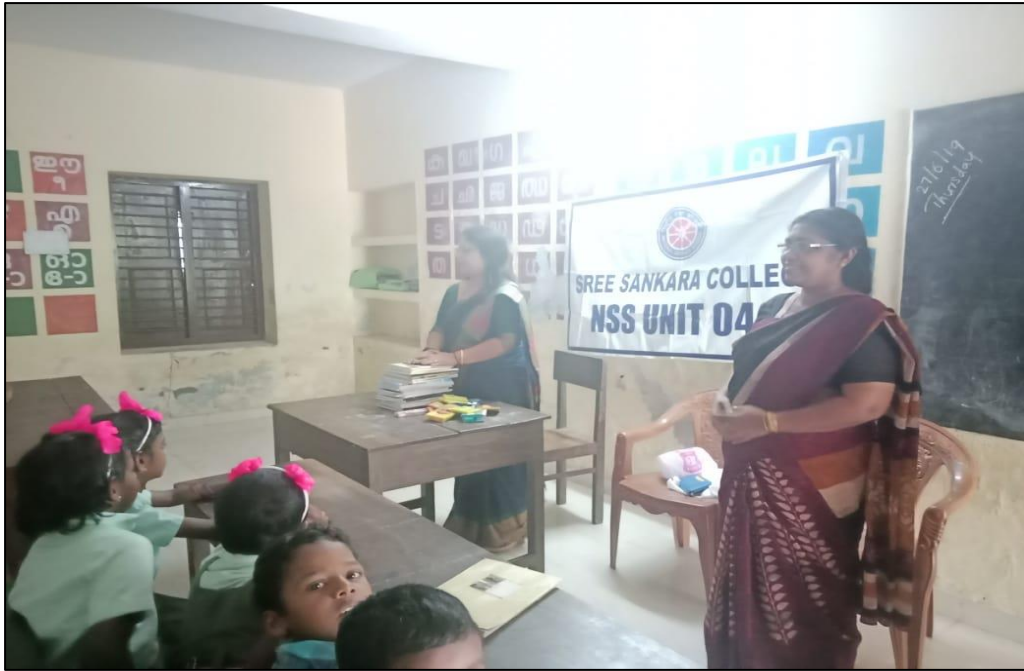

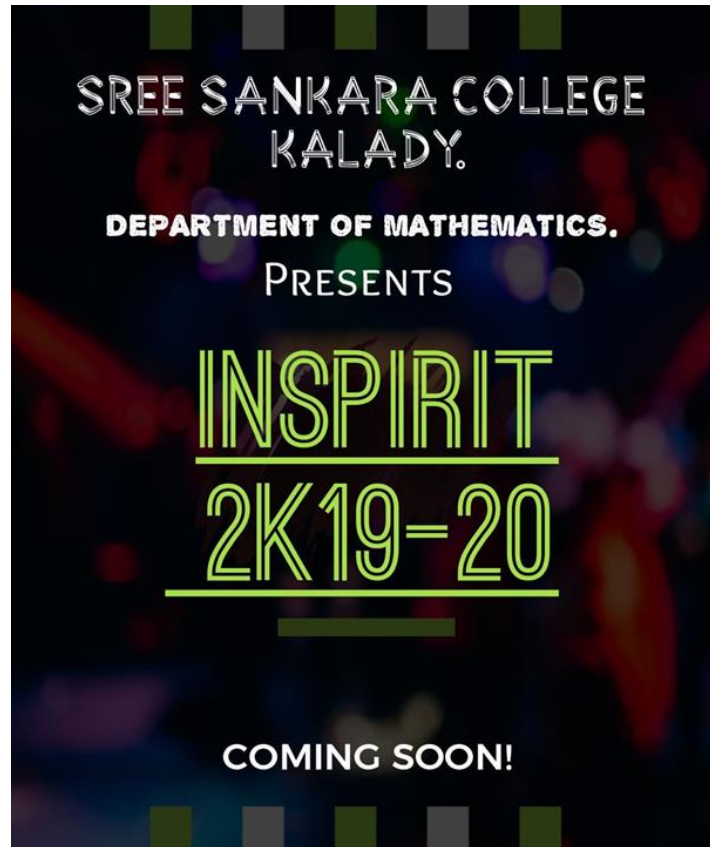
33. INSPRIT 2020 – The Mathematics exhibition- On 31st December 2019 and 1 st January 2020

63. Household survey on Waste Management - in association with Plan@Earth - 10.02-2022

An (MoU) with PLAN@Earth, a reputed non-profit organization working in the field of environmental protection since 2009, to collaborate on projects related to environmental protection activities. A Baseline Study was done in Kadungaloor Panchayath to assess the progress and effectiveness of the Waste Management System implemented by the Panchayath.
