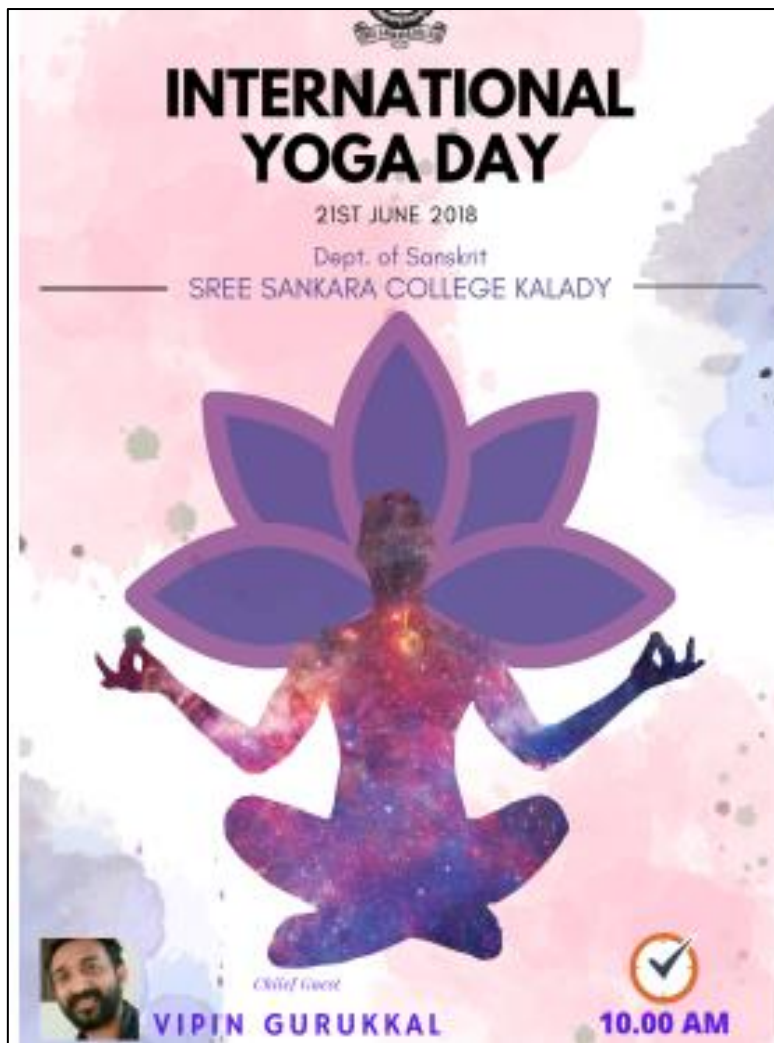

The day was delighted with a delicious speech on“Importance of Yoga - in daily life”. He also involved the students by insisting them how to do several postures.

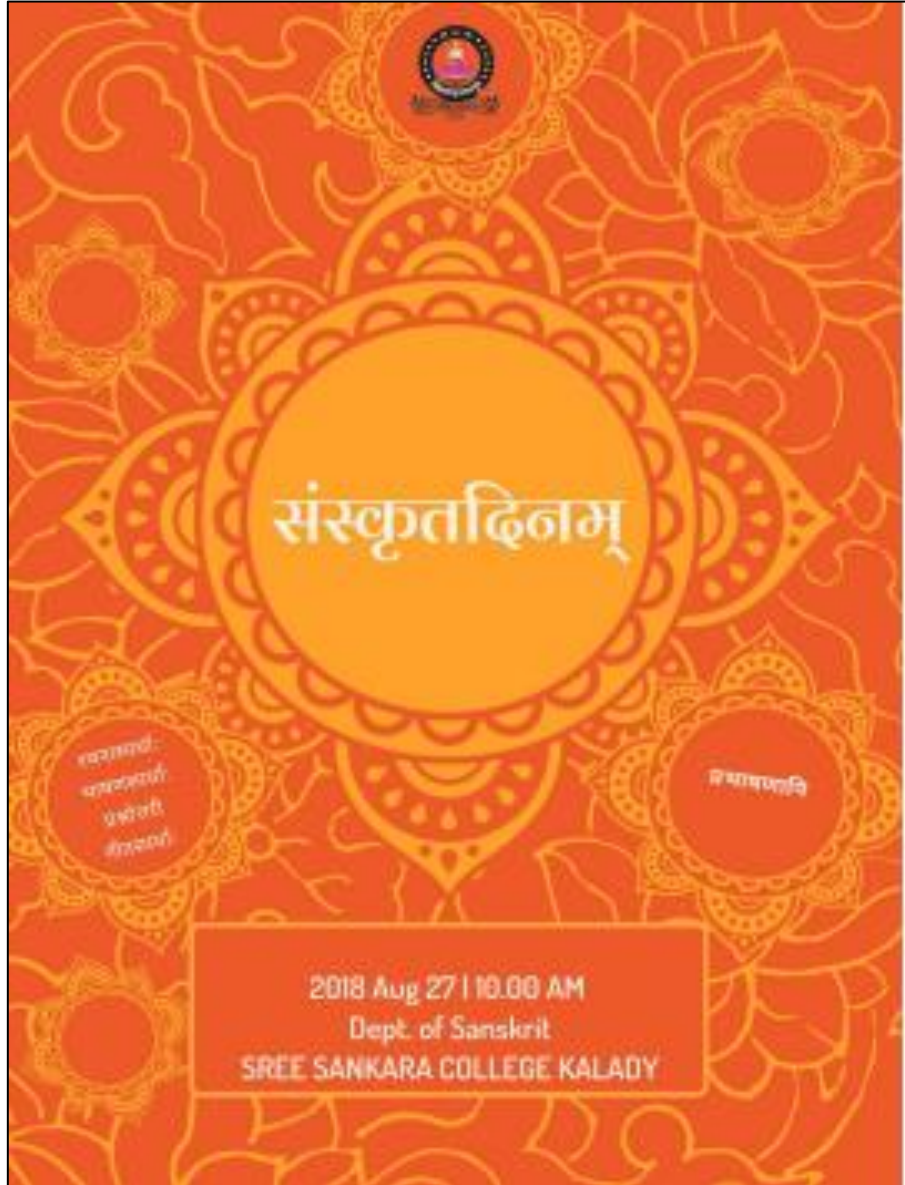
