### 1. OBJECTIVE OF THE MOU

### 2. PROPOSED MODES OF COLLABORATION

Both the parties shall collaborate for the effective conduct of the course as per the mode described below

The first party agrees to

1 Provide students for the program.

2 Finalize the date and time of the classes on mutual discussion. The schedule can be changed on mutual agreement, if needed.

3 Facilitate the evaluation, student presentation, online tests.

4The students will pay the required fees for the certificate/add on programme to the second

party.

The second party agrees to

1. Provide faculty for Vedic mathematics classes on the basis of the mutually accepted curriculum

2 The curriculum is spread for between 30 hours /60 hours.

- 3. The classes on Vedic mathematics will be conducted online during Saturdays by mutual consultation.
- 4. Each class will be of 2 hours duration.
- 5 As a part of the evaluation, online presentation, online tests and projects should be conducted by the second party.

6 Issue programme certificate to the students based on evaluation.

1) TERMS AND TERMINATION

This MOU, unless extended by mutual written agreement of the parties, shall expire in 1 (one) year after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. This MOU may be amended or terminated earlier by mutual written agreement of the parties at any time. Either party shall have the right to unilaterally terminate this MOU upon 90 days prior written notice to the other party


#### Activities under MoU with IAVM


