### **CRITERION 5: STUDENT SUPPORT AND PROGRESSION**

#### **Policy for Government and Non-Government Scholarships**

Sree Sankara College, Kalady is committed to its mission of providing quality higher education to the rural population in the eastern region of Ernakulam district in Kerala. Scholarships play a crucial role in strengthening and supporting young aspirants to advance in their academic pursuit. The Institution offers different scholarships and endowments to foster an inclusive learning environment that provides educational opportunities for all. Both Government-funded and institution-funded schemes are made available to students.

Students are encouraged to apply for government and other funded scholarships. Necessary information and guidance regarding National/State Government scholarships are updated with the students by the Scholarship Nodal Officer.

Merit scholarships, merit-cum-means scholarships and scholarships for involvement in extra-curricular activities are awarded to students from all the batches. Academically brilliant students are awarded merit scholarships. Students encountering financial constraints are supported with merit-cum-means scholarships.

The standard procedure for scholarship distribution is given below:

The process of distribution of institutional scholarships is managed by the Endowments Committee. Information regarding scholarships is circulated among all the Departments. Students are carefully chosen on the basis of the eligibility criteria defined at the institution of the respective scholarships. The Departments select students on the basis of their academic performance for the respective scholarship. The recommendation is forwarded to the Endowments Committee.

Students who excel in sports and cultural events are honoured on the Merit Day every year. Students who are awarded PhD and who excel in UGC NET as well as other competitive exams are honoured by the College Management on the Merit Day. During pandemic period students are provided with financial aid and needy students are given mobile phones to help attend online classes.

Efforts are taken to ensure parity and transparency in the distribution of financial support to deserving students.

Class XII pass out students of the current Academic Year, who are in the above 80th percentile of the respective Education Boards and pursuing regular first year UG courses in Govt./Aided colleges.

### Renewal:

- The student must have secured 50 % or more marks in the previous exam
- Must have 75 % attendance and
- Must not be involved in any ragging activities.

Rate of Scholarship: **UG-Rs. 10000/Annum; PG- Rs.-20000/Annum.**

## 2. PG Indira Gandhi Scholarship for Single Girl Child–NSP
