The department of Sanskrit in particular, ensures that the doctrines of Jagadguru Adi Sankaracharya is effectively promoted, uplifted and preserved.

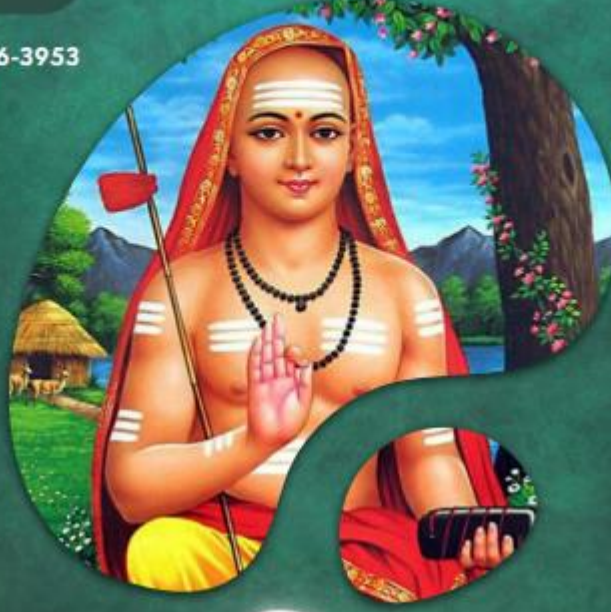
The department which focuses on Advaita Vedanta in its Undergraduate and Post Graduate programmes, has been elevated to the status of a research department, approved by Mahatma-Gandhi University, in 2006. The department publishes a research journal **Sadvidya** which is in tune with the motto of the institution and in association with Thrikkaikkaattu Swamiyar Madom disseminates Indian philosophy, Sanskrit language, and literature to common man, through weekly contact classes. The classes are conducted in three batches, with an average enrolment of 70 students every year. The admission is open to all irrespective of caste, creed, gender, and age.

The department is involved in the conservation of invaluable palm-leaf manuscripts through digitalisation. The department already possesses over 7000 folios of such digitized manuscripts, thus saving many manuscripts from destruction. The students are also trained for doing this practice. The team visits local families who possess the manuscripts and starts the digitizing procedure then and there.

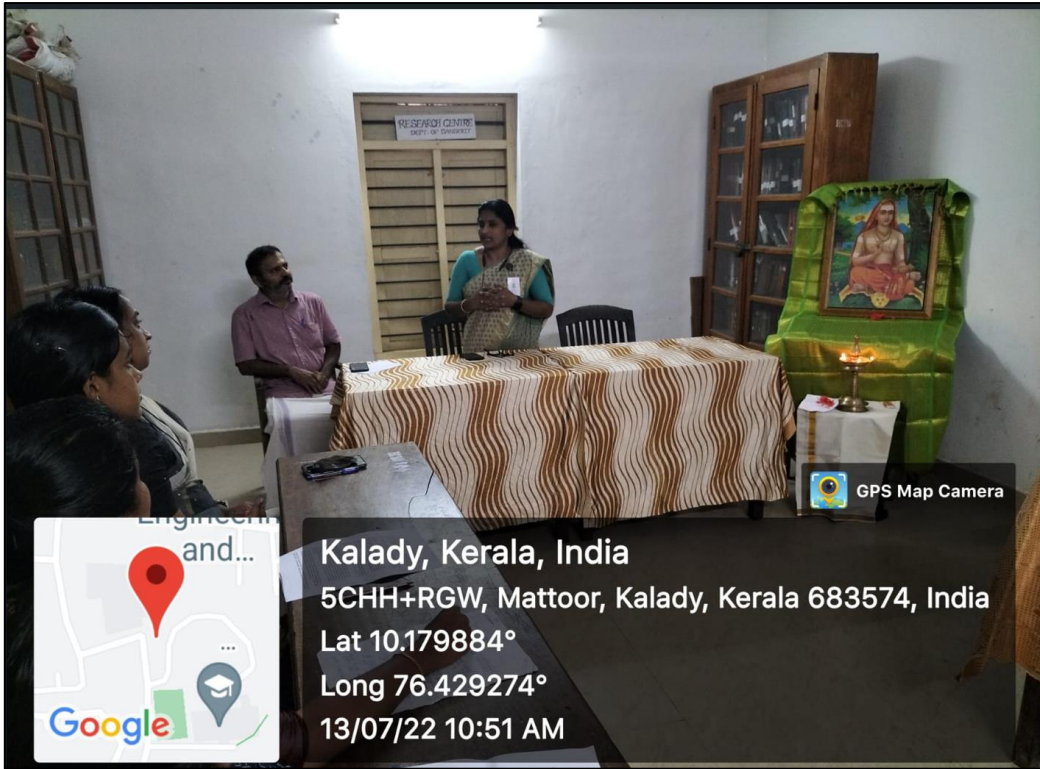

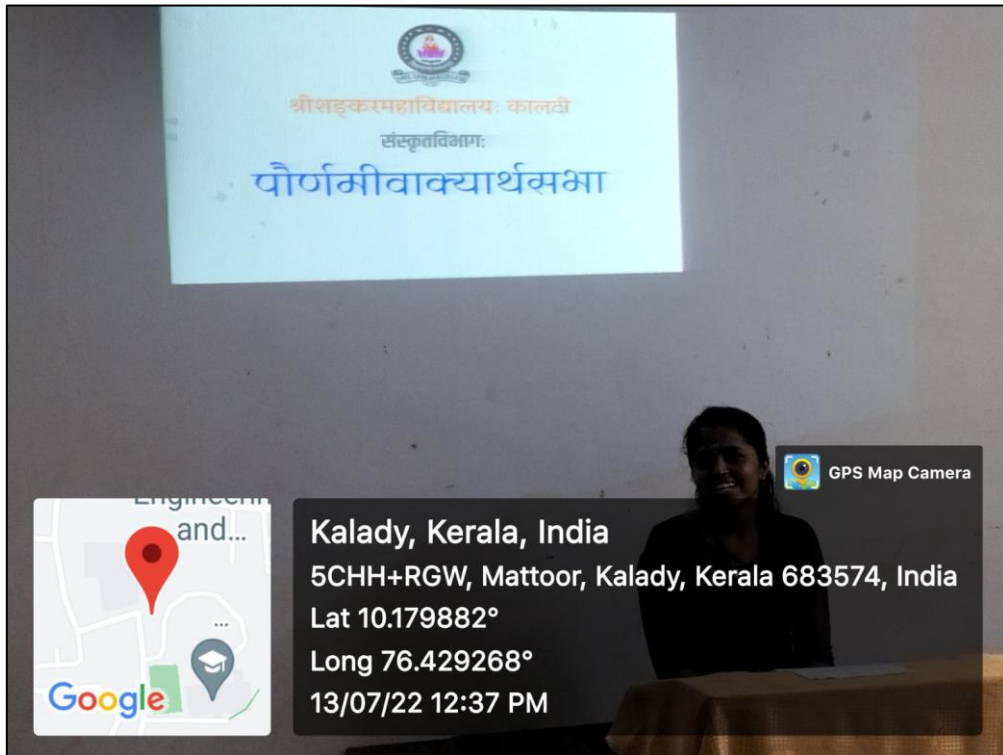

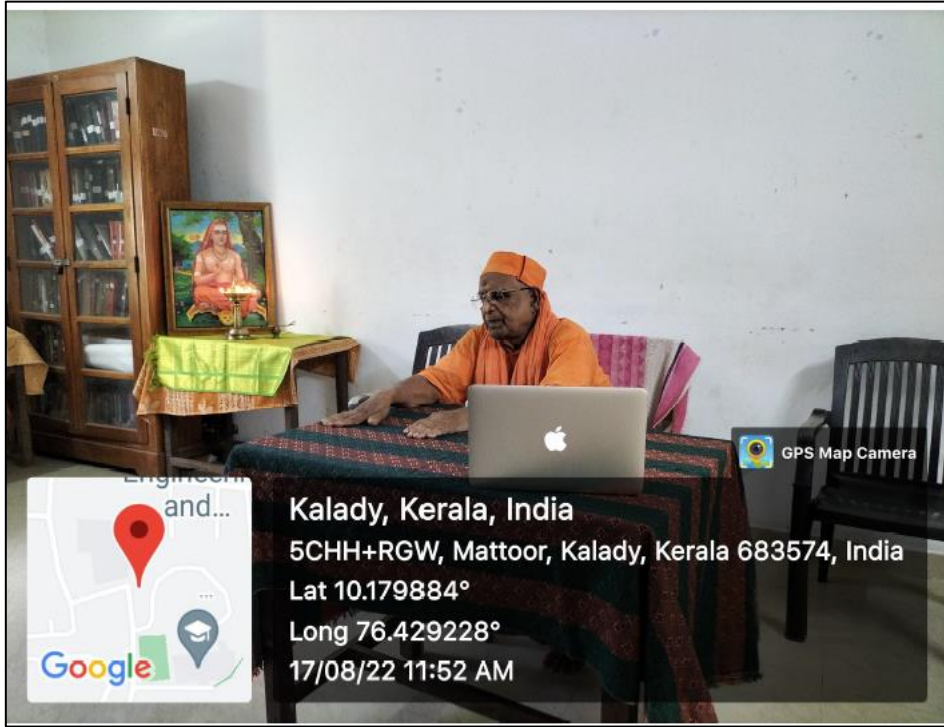

Terms and conditions:-		
1) The sanctioned amount of the project grant shall be utilized exclusively for the purpose for which it is sanctioned. Regular account shall be maintained with regard to expenditure (with receipts and cash bills) incurred out of the project grant including travel and TDS liability.		
2) The expenditure for the project, should be not more than 10% of the total project grant for contingency; not more than 30% of the total project grant for travel (domestic); not more than 40% of the total grant is to be used for books (journal/Reading materials in electronic form). The scholar may retain the assets by paying remaining 50% to ICPR. The project Guide Lines in the original application form should be strictly adhered to.

The Programme on Vaastu Shastra for practitioners runs with a view to explore India's intellectual, scientific and artistic knowledge traditions. The uniqueness of this course lies in the way it is designed to lead the student to an intimate understanding of the classical thought traditions and practices of Indian civilization through an insider's perspective.

## Learning Resources

In terms of resources, the Sanskrit section of the General Library boasts of an impressive collection of 5,000 volumes, while the department library houses approximately 1,000 volumes. This collection includes rare books on Vedabhashyas, Vasthu Sastra, Medicine, and more. There is a continuous addition of volumes to enrich the library's resources. With the intention of preserving and promoting Sanskrit Sastras, the department has conducted several training programs.

In collaboration with the Mathematics, Sanskrit, and Statistics departments, Sree Sankara College and the Indian Association of Vedic Mathematics (IAVM) jointly organized an International Conference on Vedic Mathematics. An MoU was signed with IAVM, paving the way for a Vedic mathematics course for undergraduates.
