 Heritage Club and Department of History in association with N S S Higher Secondary School, Manickyamangalam has conducted a grand Historical exhibition and Heritage Fest on 20-21 January 2020. The program was inaugurated by Honourable MLA Roji M John. The exhibition displayed 100s of collections which were once the symbols of our culture and heritage. The students also recreated the models of various antiques and other specimens including a tree house, a sacred grove, miniatures of the specimen of ancient civilisations etc. A food fest of traditional food and a tribal dance form were arranged by students which added the vibrancy of the program. Tarjani was a great success and about 1000 people including students, teachers from nearby schools and colleges came to witness the fest.
